## When to use present simple?

- 1. To express repeated actions or unchanging situations, emotions and wishes:
- \* I take the bus to the university.
- The train to Jerusalem leaves every hour.
- She sleeps eight hours every night during the week.

## 2. To express facts:

- A dog has four legs.
- We come from Switzerland.
- ∘ The rabbit **eats** corn.

## 3. To express habits:

- I get up early every day.
- Carol brushes her teeth twice a day.
- They travel to their country house every weekend.

## When to use Present Progressive?

- 1. For actions that are happening right now, while they are being talked about. for example:
- Peter is reading a book now.
- He is driving to Jerusalem at the moment.
- Please be quiet, She is sleeping now.
- 2. To indicate plans for the near future. for example:
- We are going to Basel on Saturday.
- 3. To indicate temporary operations. for example:
- I am working in Rome this month.
- 4. When time words such as: now, at the moment, Look !!, Listen!! appear.
